




Sin is any thought or behavior that is contrary to the Word of God or His character. It is anything one thinks, says or does that is displeasing to God.

Using the Above Definition of SIN, USE the Letters of S.I.N. below to write WHAT Sin is













TO ASK YOURSELF







Christianity Stands and Falls on the RESURRECTION of JESUS

Crucified

Put (someone) to death by nailing them to a cross, especially as an ancient punishment.

Resurrection

Being raised from the dead. It comes from the Greek a·na'sta·sis, which means "raising up" or "standing up again." A person who is resurrected is raised up from death and restored to life as the person he was before.




